NURSERY LEARNERS RETURNING TO LORNE NURSERY ON 22ND FEBRUARY

As you know, the First Minister confirmed on Tuesday the return to school for our Nursery to Primary 3 learners on Monday 22nd February. This is a full time return and will be closely monitored and reviewed. We are absolutely delighted to be at the point of sharing information around the Nursery learner's return to Lorne Nursery.

As with the previous return to school in August, we continue to follow the Scottish Government guidance for Early Years settings and will continue to offer the following pattern of attendance at Lorne Primary School Nursery;

1140 hours – Term time	<i>8.25am – 3.10pm (Monday to Thursday)</i> <i>8.25am – 10.55am (Friday)</i>

The drop off and pick up will be at the gates of the playground on Jameson Place (the 'back playground'). The nursery staff will meet your child there. It is really important that you ensure to **arrive and pick up on time as timings have been set so that we are following the Scottish Government COVID-19 guidance.**

As was in place previously, an enhanced cleaning programme is in place in our nursery to meet the requirements we now know are necessary to minimise the risk of transmitting the virus. This will need to take place at the end of each day.

Physical distancing between adults and between adults and children from different families must be observed. This means normal access into the school for parent and carers will continue to be severely restricted to maintain the safety of everyone. Parents and carers should not access the school playground and if learners are late to school the school office should be phoned from the front gate.

The staff and I are very much looking forward to welcoming our Nursery learners back to Lorne Nursery on Monday 22nd February.
